Friday night is our Welcome Reception, with special entertainment, drinks reception and dinner at the world-famous Royal Armouries.


Saturday night is the ESA Gala dinner with the Snake Davis Northern Rock band at the Queens Hotel.

You can be in the Yorkshire Dales within 20 minutes by car, breathing the clean air and taking in the spectacular scenery of one of the UK's largest natural parks. Then there's the North York Moors, and the Yorkshire coastline beyond. Rolling moorland, abundant wildlife, ancient woodland, and historic sites all within reach.

Urban explorers will find something totally different in the spa town of Harrogate, the heritage and history of York, or even Saltaire, a UNESCO World Heritage site, where Victorian streets and towering factories lie perfectly preserved, hiding art by the likes of David Hockney.



#### How to get to Leeds:-

#### Leeds Airport code is LBA

Local airlines include Jet2, Ryanair and KLM as well as Aer Lingus, easyJet, and Wizz Air.

#### Manchester is our closest major airport – the code is MAN

There is a very frequent train service direct from the airport to the Leeds City Station which takes 90 minutes and costs about €15 and this brings you directly to the Queens Hotel – just get off the train and walk in to the hotel lobby! Major airlines serving Manchester include British Airways, Air France, KLM, Lufthansa, American Airlines, Delta, Emirates, Etihad, Qatar Airways, as well as Jet2, Ryanair, easyJet and Brussels Airlines.
